

SCHEME OF WRITTEN TEST

1. There will be one paper of General English compulsory for all including the candidate for Hindi and Sanskrit subjects. It will be a qualifying subject carrying 20 marks. The candidate needs to score the cut off marks to be decided on the basis of the performance of candidates. Those who score cut off marks will be considered eligible and accordingly his/her optional paper of written test will be evaluated.
2. **For PGT:-** The candidate has to attempt a subject of his/her subject which he/she has the eligible and applied for. This paper will carry 70 marks.
3. **For TGT :-** The candidate has to attempt a subject of his/her subject which he/she has the eligible and applied for. This paper will carry 70 marks..
4. **For PRT :-** The candidates applying for this grade will also have to appear in two subject carrying 35 marks each. The subjects must be of that group the candidates have opted at Graduation level.
5. **For Librarian:-** The candidates of this grade will have to appear in the written test for 70 marks.
6. **For LDC :-** The candidate of this grade will have to appear in the written test for 70 marks.

The Merit list of the successful candidates will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in the optional subjects only i.e. out of 70 marks. The marks for interview will be 30 and final merit list, so will be prepared on the basis marks secured out of 100.

NOTE:- The Wellness Teacher and Special Educator has to appear in the subject related to their field carrying 35 marks and another subject of 35 marks they have to marks for the subject studied at Graduation level.
